ORGANIZATIONAL BACKGROUND

Kalladka - lush green country side, about 30 KM to the east of Mangalore, spread on either side of the Mangalore- Bangalore highway (N.H 48), is a small village of 6000 people. A township of petty traders, agricultural labourers and beedi-rollers had only one Govt. Primary school until 1980.



By 1980 the sustained efforts of a small group of social activists gave birth to Sri Rama High School, Kalladka. VISION & MISSION

True education is not limited to academics. Schooling is not confined to learning formulae and grammar. True education should help to unfold the child's personality. Only such a child would be an asset to the society. Therefore the school should be a source of inspiration and idealism, which moulds his character and outlook. Our own cultural heritage and Dharma serve as inexhaustible sources of inspiration and idealism. Thus various rules and norms of behavior are defined with a clear goal of imparting complete education.

VALUE ORIENTED SYSTEMS

- A school is a temple of learning. Therefore the child enters his classroom the abode of Goddess *Saraswati* with due devotion, leaving his footwear outside.
- As per our ancient Hindu culture Food, Education and health facility were free to all in the olden days. But now a days these are made money earning media. Thus to restore Bharathiyathva in the younger generation and protect social harmony Shri Rama Vidyakendra Trust took the task of '*Grama Vikas*' (Adarsha grama)
- Free Education right from "*Shishumandir* upto 10th Std.
- Two Pairs of Uniform and along with text books and other Exercise books etc.
- Right from the nursery level the Child starts learning Sanskrit, the mother of all our languages. As the child grows up, he can absorb easily, the priceless treasure of knowledge and wisdom.
- Teachers and children together share the responsibility of keeping the campus clean and green throughout the year . It is aimed at developing inclination for the love of nature and dignity of labour among children.
- The name of Sri Rama is the "watchword" in the school campus. Teachers as well students greet each other with 'Jai Sri Ram' and bid farewell with 'Ram Ram' slogans.
- Teachers as well as students observe dress- code. The uniforms inculcate the spirit of swadeshi, and simplicity.
- Instead of identifying the classrooms by numbers or alphabets, they are named after the great heroes of our history. Thus the child is constantly reminded of the nobility and idealism of *Nachiketa*, *Dhruva*, *Bharata*, *Chandrashekhara Azad*, *sister Niveditha* etc.
- Apart from independence Day and Republic Day, several other national festivals such as 'Gurupooja' and 'Rakhi' are celebrated in the school.
- All the teachers and students come together in the morning and evening to recite patriotic songs and immortal inspiring quotations.

OUR PROGRAMMES

- **SARASWATHI VANADANA:**

The day starts with *saraswathi vandana*. All the students of our institution assemble in the hall and participate in the morning prayer. Where they sing the prayer of *Saraswathi, Bharatha matha* followed by one minute of *Dhyana* and chanting *Gayathrimanthra*. *Saraswathi Vandana* helps a lot to concentrate on their studies.



- **FREE MIDDAY MEAL:**

Education means all - round development. The whole process is not possible with empty stomach. Keeping this in view, we have started the free midday meal programme ‘*Annapoorna*’, which feeds the needs of 2881 students.



- **AAGATHA SWAGATHA:**

In the beginning of the year *Praveshotsava* is arranged to welcome newly admitted children. Every child is welcomed with *Vedamanthra, Arathi* and *Thilak Dharanam*. Child performs ‘*Yagna*’ by putting *Grutham* to holly fire and get blessings from elders.

- **DEEPAPRADANA:** The final farewell function of out going students is the culmination of the string of 'Samskaras' they have received during their stay in the school. They feel charged with a sense of love and obligation to the society as well as the nation they live in.



Navadampathi Samavesha' -

Arranging a huge and holistic conference of newly married couple of the year - this year it is 141 couples- they are enlightened by the elder thinkers of Hindu philosophy and elder couple. *Bharathiya Kutumba* is explained to them and their future life is guaranteed with no divorce.

- **Samagra Shishu Shikshana Kendra:-** Child's physical, mental development in the presence of cultural and religious background is scientifically arranged with research oriented practical approach. All round development of the child of the age group from 3 to 6 is achieved by this play way as well as activity based, skill oriented approach.



- **'AKSHARABHYASA'** function is arranged on the occasion of 'Sharada Puja' on Vijayadashami day. Pujaniya Swamini Mathanandamayi of odiyoor kshethra gracing the children.



- ***Kutumba Prabodhan Varga'*** to all parents, in which hundreds of families get together and get enlightened.
- ***'Deepa Pujan' and Samarasya Bhojana:*** An unique programme is arranged to overcome castism and to achieve social harmony. All the parents and students offer 'pushparchana' to 'Bharathamatha' and they bring food prepared at home and have lunch under moonlight called 'samuhika samarasya Bhojan' which unite all in oneness thus inculcating National unity.



- **Medical aid camps** are arranged every year. More than thousand beneficiaries' turnout every year. Since three years we are arranging Ayurvedic medical camps, ENT, Dental camps also.



- **Free yoga classes** and yoga treatment courses and *Sanskrit Sambhashan Shibhir* (Spoken samskritha camps) to the public were arranged every year. For the all round development of child cultural activities like *Bharatha natya*, Music, *yakshagana* as well as yogasana, Karate, Judo and fine arts are taught. Students participate in several social gathering like *Gramothsava*, *Shramaseva* to develop social mingling with society. They also participate in protests to gain courage to tackle social injustice to the poor and downtrodden.



- **University level Conferences** on National issues such as 'internal and external National challenges', 'Ancient and modern achievements of *Bharath*' are arranged every year. More than 600 students from 50+ colleges were participated. These conferences inspire the young minds and mould them as fruitful citizens of our country.



Nationala & cultural Festival



: Every year we celebrate National festivals like Independence day, Republic day etc to fill National spirits in them. Cultural festivals like *Thulasi pooja*, *Gopooja*, *sarasvati pooja* etc, are also held to give them true knowledge of our Nobel tradition and rich culture.

- **Nature Consciousness programs:**

Under this program we provide plants to the students guide them to plant and take care of its growth. Programs of identifying the medical importance of different plants are also conducted.



- **Eye donation camp:** More than 100 students, teachers and parents came forward to donate their eyes in our eye donation camp.

- **Folk Arts Training**

Weakly calsses of Bharatha Natya, Yakshagana, Karntic music and instrumental music classes are conducted.



- **Enrichment programs:**

Subject enrichment programs are conducted every year for our teachers by the educational department as well as by the management. Several national resource persons are invited and they inspire our teachers to have teaching learning preocess activity based and culturally rooted.

- **Aid to Challenged students:** Every year we conduct special medical camp to find out the challenged students. We provide them necessary aid and help them to continue their education along with normal students.

- **Co-curricular clubs:** Students are grouped according to their aptitude and interest under different clubs. Activities like blood grouping by health club. Science fair—exhibition of different science models—by Science club, Swadeshi awareness programme by swadeshi club, linguistic and literary activities by the language clubs are conducted every year.



- **Personality Development program :** TO develop all round development of our students we conduct programs like Brain train, Carrier guidance how to face examination, yoga classes and counseling to overcome stress.



Internet world: To understand the importance and the uses of internet training program for students of neighboring schools held every year.

- **Empowering the women:** Tailor classes, computer classes and driving classes are held to develop skills among village women of our locality. They are provided with economic stability under several schemes.



- **Bhajanas and Satsangha:** To Mould the young mind in a proper way, we are arranging monthly *Bhajanas* and *Satsangha* programs. Birthday is celebrated as '*Samuhika Huttuhabba*' and every child offers *Samaprpna Nidhi* on that day.

- **Agricultural training :** Students are trained in sowing harvesting in the fields. Traditional paddy cultivation in all stages is experienced by the students who participate in this programme. Children are trained and encouraged to grow flower and vegetable plants.



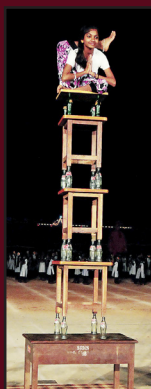
Kreedothsava :

SRI RAMA VIDYA KENDRA KALLADKA is a unique experiment in the field of education . To inculcate our inherited Bharathiya culture in the young minds and to promote self esteemed high thinking with creativity amongst the future citizens of this great country we arrange several special programmes throughout the year.

One of these programmes is “KREEDOTHSAVA”. After prolonged training and practice the children display breath taking feasts for about 2 hours .

The important features of this show are

- 1.The programme is a unique one.
- 2.The programme is arranged at 6 p.m. under the flood light.
3. All the 2881 students of the Vidya kendra participate in the programme.
4. More than 10,000 spectators come from all over Karnataka
- 5.This is not the sports competitions as held in other schools. Students display various physical and cultural talents - individual as well as in groups.



The programme includes :

1. A full pledged Band set Welcomes the audience. The Drums salute, trumpets say good wishes while flute melody catches your hearts with Bharathiya Ragas. To the tune of music students display structural formations that reflect a message.
2. Cultural as well as folk dances of several groups of 60-100 children wearing colour full dresses. eg. *Kolatam*, *Karag*, *Deepanrithya*, *Hamsanrithya*, *Janapada Nrithya*.
3. Magnificent shows by the selected groups of pupil in the art of *Karate*, *Yogasana* and *Gymnasiyam*.
4. Individual talents like complicated *Yogasanas*, *Yogasana* on rope and *Mallakambha*, Balancing on bottle. Cycling and balancing on bike, cycle, one wheeled cycle are the other attractive items.
5. Addition to this the whole group of Primary school and Highschool students participate to form various beautiful designs and patterns on the ground changing it to the tune of music or song. These shows remind the inauguration festivals of Asiad or Olympics.
6. Thrilling experience is the torch show boys and girls jumping through the fire rings, Scatting on the wheels.

All these programmes conducted to lighten the awareness about the ideals of our great country. Value additions within the system played right role to its full potential. Cooperation displaced competition, reverence replaced rivalry. Values and ideals ruled over passion and ego.

FUTURE PLANS

- Wellfurnished and wellknit Science Laboratory and School Library which can reflect the talents and thoughts of both our ancient, modern scholars and scientists.
- To have sound body, which brings out all round development of a child, we need spacious Play Ground, Indoor stadium and Swimming pool.
- A Technical Training School which can serve the purpose of providing opportunities for the rural and poor students who are deprived of such opportunities.

- An Auditorium & Annapoorna Dining hall complex to accommodate 3000 students at a time and have their Mid day meal.
